

## Tips And Tricks Of Praying

- 1- **Be honest with God** – When you pray it's good to be honest with God, he knows if you're lying!!! It's good when you pray to be able to tell God anything, it could be a rant or ramble or just confession saying sorry for the things you know you shouldn't have done.
- 2- **You are a product of prayer** – When you pray remember, Prayer Works! – You are a product of prayer, someone (probably more people) were praying for you before you made a commitment to Christ, and they probably continue to pray for you!
- 3- **Stand in the gap for others** – If you are a product of prayer make someone else part of yours, you all probably know people who don't know Christ, pray for them!
- 4- **Faith-Filled Perspective** – Believe when you pray that God **will** answer your prayers, sometimes not the way you expected or even what you wanted but he knows best.
- 5- **Give glory back to God** – When you pray it's good to praise and thank God for thing he's done, for answered prayers, for good days...even for bad days!
- 6- **Remember – Praying can be tricky!** – Many Christians find praying difficult but persevere because God is listening and hanging onto every word you say.
  
- 7- **Listen for God** – Conversations are a two way thing, try and let God have a word in edge-ways. Sometimes it's good just to sit still quietly and listen for God, perhaps have some quiet music on, have a bible handy, God might stick a verse in your head!
